

DEATH -We regret to report the death at the age of 73 of Mr Joseph Shuker of Cox Bank, on Saturday morning last after a fortnight's illness.

The deceased was on a visit to his daughter Mrs S Lawrence of Lightwood Green at the time.

He was a skilled drainer and also a brick and tile maker. He was foreman over the laying of the gas mains in Audlem when they were laid. He was also an old member of the ---Pride of our Town A.O.O. Foresters. He had seven sons and two daughters. The funeral took place at Audlem cemetery on ----afternoon, the service being conducted by the Rev. J. Stapleton Cotton, who made touching references to the character of the deceased. His remains were enclosed in a coffin, which was labelled Joseph Shuker, died Jan 24 1914.
