John Bowen of Audlem one of the wireless operators on HMS **Minotaur** played a prominent part in the destruction of the German battleship **Emden**. He received a message of the Emden's position and at once forwarded it to HMS **Sydney** which destroyed it.

30/10 'flu epidemic

2/11/1918 death of Miss Pickerill, from the influenza? great loss to the school, keen asst mistress for several years.

8/11/1918 school closed for another week

11/11/1918 the war is over God be thanked

29/11 school has been closed 2 weeks

5/12 MOH closes school until after Christmas
